Why do we receive an offering in chapel?

Every Tuesday the elementary students gather for a time of worship and a Bible lesson. During this chapel, we also receive an offering. The question could be asked why receive an offering in a room full of elementary students. There are two primary reasons for doing this.

I was amazed to see the kids get behind this initiative and we were so excited when we reached our goal as we realized we did this together.

This semester we have the same goal of 5 juta that is going toward the tuition of a young man named Darminto who attends seminary in Jakarta. Darminto has a calling of ministry upon his life and it is amazing that the elementary students of BAIS are partnering with him to help make his calling reality.

Just as in the book of Acts, our kids are learning that together we can make a real difference and that it is truly "more blessed to give than to receive."
