## School Clinic Info



This week and last we have seen several students with upper respiratory symptoms and fevers. As per the parent student handbook, students will be sent home if any of the symptoms/diseases listed are present (“determining illness” and “sending a student home”).

Check your child(ren) daily for any fever before they leave for school.

Please take the following actions to protect yourself and others:

1. Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
2. Wear a mask if you have a cough or runny nose.
3. Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
4. Wash your hands often with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.
5. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread this way.
6. Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs like the flu.

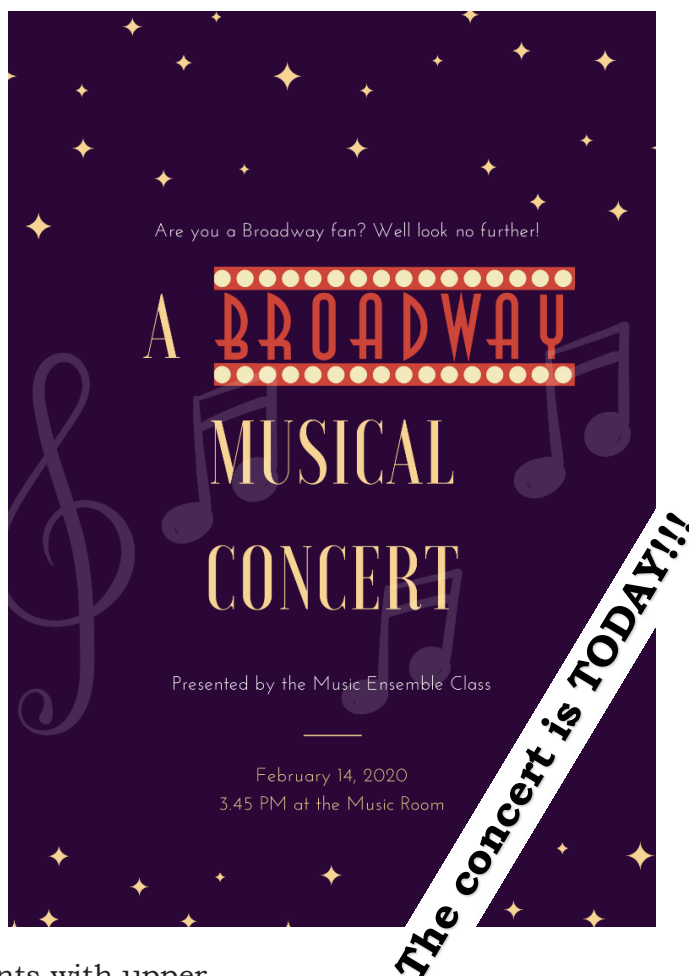
Together we can stop spreading the germs!

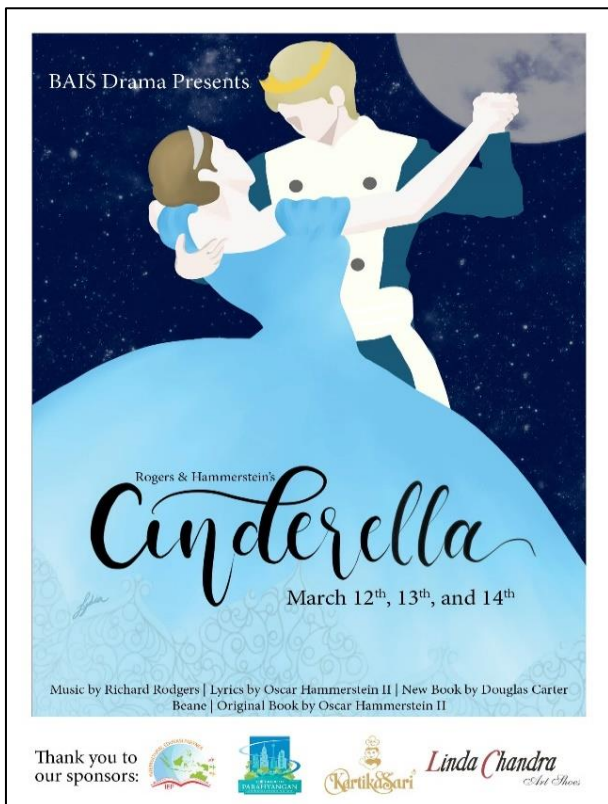
