From Technology Department

Hello! Welcome to the 21-22 school year from the BAIS Tech Department. As we navigate online schooling, we wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with some basic information that will help your student to have a smooth and successful experience.

• Ensure that you have enough bandwidth

A single Google Meet call with 10 participants, <u>uses</u> <u>approximately 4Mbps</u> of download and 3.2Mbps of upload

bandwidth. So, please ensure that your Internet Service Provider (ISP) provides you with appropriate bandwidth to support that. Also, make sure that no other devices at home are streaming (Netflix, Spotify, YouTube, etc.) content during Google Meet class calls. As a starting point, we would recommend at least 20Mbps for a single student in your household. If you have multiple students, then please consider having 40Mbps or more of bandwidth package from your ISP.

Good router to handle the WiFi traffic

Most WiFi modem/routers provided by your ISPs don't do a good job in handling traffic from multiple devices and also providing a good strong signal around your home. Our recommendation would be to purchase a good WiFi router that can handle the WiFi connectivity of the devices in your home and turn off the WiFi on your ISP provided modem. Here's a list of some good WiFi routers:

- a. For small single storey house:
 - i. Asus RT-AX55U
 - ii. Mikrotik hAP ac2
 - iii. TP-Link Archer AX10
 - iv. Mi Router 4A
- b. For medium size house:
 - i. Google Nest WiFi Router and 1 or 2 Point
 - ii. Asus Zenwifi AX Mini XD4
 - iii. TP Link Mesh WiFi Deco E4 or M5 (2 or 3 pack)
 - iv. Tenda Nova MW6 (2 or 3 pack)
- c. For large homes
 - i. ASUS ZenWiFi AX (XT8) 2 pack or 4 pack
 - ii. Google Nest WiFi Router and 2 or more points
 - iii. Netgear Orbi RB582 with 2 or more satellites

Regularly update the software on the computer

Ensure that the operating system updates are applied on a regular basis on the computers. Also ensure that the browser is up to date, Chrome usually requires a restart for updates to be applied. It is also a good idea to shut













down the computer at the end of the day and power them up the following day, as that will release all of the memory allocation from various programs and will enhance the responsiveness of the device. This applies to tablets and Chromebooks as well.
